President's Announcements

- Pete Detmering opened the meeting by leading the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Pete then asked for a moment of silence in memory of those lost in the attacks of 9/11.

Secretary's Report

 Janet Doremus mentioned that the minutes from the prior meeting were distributed via email and asked if there were any questions, comments or corrections. She then asked for a motion to approve the minutes as written. Anita Sands made the motion, Rich Cross seconded and the Members present voted in favor of the motion.

Treasurer's Report

- Dave Eikhorst reported that we anticipate:
 - a \$2.8k refund from Toms River for the Security Guard they were not able to supply
 - spending \$3.5k to install winter fencing

• Finance Committee Report

- In Arnie Morris' absence, Dave reported that our financial position is \$10k better than that shown in the Actual 2016 Budget Forecast prepared in August, due in part to the \$25k in Renters Badge Sales and a \$3k reduction in Legal Fees for the easement work.
- A motion to accept the 2017 Budget as presented was made by Scott Jefferey, seconded by Chick Krug and the Members voted to approve.

Ocean Beach Report

- Jeff Bailey reported:
 - Next season, our lifeguards will be on duty:
 - From 10am to 5:30pm, to be in synch with the surrounding beaches.
 - For Father's Day weekend (June 17th and 18th) and then daily from June 23rd through Labor Day.
 - In the coming weeks, Jeff, in conjunction with Toms River, will begin installing winter fencing and closing up the access ways.

- Jeff then went on to discuss the problems with teenagers/young adults congregating on the beach at night.
 - Janet Doremus and Gabby Dudas had spoken to Ralph Stocco, Neighborhood Watch from TRPD, who mentioned that they intended to increase patrols beginning in July which should keep things at bay. Unfortunately, with social media, word of these types of gatherings spreads like wild fire. We did not experience the additional patrols that were promised. Although TRPD would come if called, they were not proactively patrolling the beach front.
 - Pete Detmering had made arrangements for an off-duty officer to patrol the beach; after sending in payment of \$2.8k in advance, no officer was willing to take the job and we are now seeking a refund from Toms River.
 - Jeff Bailey was able to contract with ??? Security to have a security guard on duty Friday and Saturday nights (as well as Labor Day) for the remainder of the season. This will continue in 2017, with the guard on duty over Memorial Day weekend and then Friday and Saturday nights in season, beginning on Friday, June 17th.
 - Jeff also mentioned that he is pursuing the cost of power/lighting (either electric or solar) to illuminate the beach front at night and possibly installing a beach cam (like Chadwick has) to discourage vandalism.
- Kevin Seiler proposed that a Committee be formed to approach Toms River with suggestions for additional patrols/support on the beach at night. The following people have volunteered to be part of the Committee:

- A question was raised by John Kolmos regarding access to the beach, both now and after the beach restoration project is completed. He mentioned that it is difficult for elderly people as well as those with strollers or beach buggies to climb up and down the dunes. He suggested that we install MobiMats, like Normandy Beach has done. Jeff Bailey agreed to look into the matter; however it is expected to be very expensive. Janet Doremus mentioned that at the meetings she attended with the DEP and Toms River it was mentioned that the project would not be installing wooden walk overs; however, Toms River indicated they would consider installing MobiMats, which would save us a tremendous amount of money.

Bay Beach Report

- Fred Manuel reported that:
 - There was little swimming activity at the Bay Beach this year; somedays there was no one. Therefore, there will be NO lifeguard at the Bay Beach next season; signs have been posted to swim at your own risk.
 - The Bay Beach Committee will be exploring additional equipment to be installed at the north end of the bay area, hopefully for the Spring.
