streets situate in the Township of Dover, in the County of Ocean and State of New Jersey, being known and designated as East Colony Road, Surf Road, North Surf Road and South Surf Road in Section D on a plan entitled "Silver Beach, Chadwicks, Dover Township, N.J." surveyed February, 1938, by R. White Morris and being more particularly described as follows:

TOGETHER with all and singular, the buildings, improvements, woods, ways, rights, liberties, privileges, hereditaments and appurtenances, to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues, and the profits thereof, and of every part and parcel thereof:

right, title, interest, property, possession, claim and demand whatsoever, both in law and equity, of the said party of the first part, of, in and to the said premises, with the appurtenances.
