Dear Silver Beach Members,

As we informed you earlier, our good friend and Treasurer, Ken Takacs passed away and we are transitioning his responsibilities to our Finance Trustee, Andrea Greco, who has graciously agreed to assume these responsibilities.

Please bear with us. Obviously, this is difficult, especially with our EC members scattered at this time of year. As a result, the 2018 Year-End Financial Statement, which is normally attached to this letter will be delayed. We hope to distribute it by email prior to the Spring Membership Meeting

2019 MEMBERSHIP DUES:

As mentioned in the Fall 2018 Membership Letter, and approved at our 2018 Fall Membership Meeting, our 2019 Dues will remain at \$450.

Additional Members Badges may be purchased with your Dues at a rate of \$25 each until June 8th. Thereafter, Additional Members Badges may be purchased at the rate of \$50 per badge.

Our **Tennis Club** is now the **Silver Beach Tennis/Pickleball Club**. As proposed and approved at the Fall Meeting, the court has been relined to accommodate both tennis and pickleball. If you wish to play, the annual Tennis/Pickleball Dues will remain at \$75.

The <u>Due Date for the payment of 2019 Membership Dues</u> is <u>June 8, 2019</u>, the date of the Spring Membership Meeting. Any payments received after that date will be subject to a <u>\$50 late fee</u>, without exception.

Please Note:

In order to keep our records in order, we ask that EVERYONE return the original 2019 Dues Form with their Dues payment. This will facilitate our bookkeeping as well as any updates that need to be made to the Membership List.

o If you are using electronic banking, please send one check per property and put the <u>Member's name</u>, <u>Silver Beach street address and invoice number in the notes</u> so we can determine where to apply the payment. This is particularly important if you are paying with a business account that we may not be able to associate to your Membership. We also ask that you send in the <u>original 2019 Dues Form</u>, with a note reflecting the date the payment was made and the banking institution that made the payment. This will enable us to ensure that the payment is distributed appropriately, between dues, tennis, extra badges and donations.

OCEAN BEACH

Ocean Beach Opening

As discussed and approved at the 2018 Fall Membership Meeting, in 2019 our lifeguards will be on duty at the ocean beach:

Daily from 10am to 5:30pm

This is to stay in synch with the surrounding beaches to avoid incurring additional liability when their guards go off duty.

We hope to open the ocean beach for the weekend of June 15-16th, and then daily commencing on Friday, June 21st, through Labor Day.

We continue to invest in and rebuild Silver Beach as part of our on-going recovery from Superstorm Sandy and appreciate the continued support of our Membership. We have successfully initiated and completed several restoration projects, the bay beach restoration is almost complete, but now that the Army Corps beach replenishment project is complete, we are facing some hefty expenses at the ocean beach.

Below are several pictures of the walkovers that have recently been completed by Toms River.





Many thanks to Arlene Kennedy of South Surf Road for all the photos she posted on Facebook throughout the project.

Initially, we will be grading the approaches to the dune walkovers, and placing mobi-mats and fencing from all six streets in Silver Beach to connect to the dune walkovers. Work will begin on this shortly. We hope to complete this effort before Memorial Day weekend.

After the entranceways are complete, we will be seeking volunteers to form a committee to define what we can do in the open area behind the dune on the north end and to find a permanent solution for lifeguard shelter and beach badge sales. These projects will require the full support of the Membership in the future. We are hopeful that each of you will maintain your Membership for 2019 and beyond in support of this recovery effort!

OCEAN BEACH BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT

We would like to form an Ocean Beach Beautification Committee to address the esthetics of our beach, once it has been restored and the walkovers and dunes are in place. This may include, but is not limited to:

- Installing a flag pole (or flag poles -might be nice to have one north and one south so that all can see)
- Installing beach lighting
- Reinstalling the volleyball court
- Reinstalling bike racks at the entrances
- o Installing benches at the entrances (either at the street side or beach side) and at the walkway bump outs at the top of the dunes for seniors
- Installing planters at the street ends
- Providing a place to sell badges
- Providing a place to store lifeguard equipment and provide shelter for the guards during breaks and storms
- Other ideas??
 - We may have some "dead space" west of the permanent dune on the north end that we would like to take advantage of for either business or recreation

TRASH AND RECYCLING REMINDER:

Trash Schedule

- During the off-season, trash is picked up on Mondays, except on holidays, when it is picked up on Tuesday
- During the prime season (May 23rd August 30th), trash will be picked up on Mondays and Thursdays, except on holidays, when it will be picked up the following day for the remainder of the week.

Recycling Schedule

- o During the off-season, recycling is picked up on the 1st and 3rd Mondays of the month.
- During the prime season (May 23rd August 30th), recyclables will be picked up every week on FRIDAYS.

Please Note:

Trash on Memorial Day Weekend and Labor Day Weekend will be picked up on Tuesday (not Monday). Trash will also be picked up on Friday after Memorial Day Weekend (not Thursday).

Trash on **Independence Day** (July 4th) will be picked up on **Friday** (not Thursday)

Reminder: Paper and cardboard may be co-mingled with all other recyclable material in a <u>separate container</u> with a <u>detachable lid</u>. The container must be no larger than 30 gallons and must not exceed 40 pounds when full.

If you will not be around on pick-up day, please do not put your trash out in plastic bags...the seagulls look at this as a buffet breakfast and leave a big mess in their wake. Please ask one of your neighbors to take in your cans. They'd rather do this than clean up the mess...believe me!

We also ask Members who rent their home to pass this information on to their renters and provide them with proper containers.

2019 BEACH BADGE RATES

- The general public, including Non-Members and the Guests and Renters of Non-Members, must purchase Daily Beach Badges from the Badge Checker at the Ocean Beach when lifeguards are on duty.
 - The cost for these Daily Beach Badges is \$9.00
- Renters of a Member or Guests of a Member may purchase discounted Beach Badges at the Lifeguard Shed on weekends or from the Badge Checker during the week from 11am to 3pm, as follows:

1 Week \$45.00
2 Weeks \$80.00
3 Weeks \$115.00
4 Weeks \$145.00

- Weekly Beach Badges are issued for the covered period from Saturday (10am) to Saturday (10am).
- Lost Beach Badges must be re-purchased for remainder of rental period.

MEMBERSHIP PRIVLEGES

- Upon payment of the current year's Dues and Assessments, if applicable, each Voting Member will receive eight (8) Member's Beach Badges, which permit the Member and their family and guests to use the Ocean and Bay Beaches.
- Additional Member's Beach Badges may be purchased at any time at the rates specified above.
- Member's Beach Badges may either be picked up at the Spring Meeting or at the shed on the top of Silver Beach Road or from the Badge Checker during the Season.
- Member's Beach Badges are for the sole use of Members, their family, and their guests.
- Member's Beach Badges may only be used when the Member's family is in attendance.
- Member's Beach Badges may not be used by Silver Beach property owners who are Non-Members.
- Guest's may not use Member's Beach Badges when the Member's family is not in attendance.
- Renters may not use Member's Beach Badges at any time.
- Members allowing such guests or renters to use a Member's Beach Badge will be subject to a fine of \$400, confiscation of the Member's Beach Badges and suspension of membership privileges until the fine is paid.
- Members found to be in repeated violation of the Associations By-Laws and/or Rules and Regulations may have their Membership suspended or terminated by a majority vote of the Executive Committee.

HOURS OF OPERATION

- Ocean Beach: In 2019 lifeguards will be on duty on the weekend of June 15th to 16th and daily thereafter from Friday, June 21st to Monday, September 2ndd, 2018.
 - Daily 10am 5:30pm
- Please note: this schedule may be changed due to the Army Corps. Beach Replenishment Project. Please observe the instructions of the lifequards.
- Bay Beach: CLOSED FOR SWIMMING No life guard on duty.
- All swimmers MUST exit the water at the close of the day until the Lifeguards leave the beach. Swimming when Lifeguards are not on duty is discouraged and at your own risk.
- Curfews:

Bay Beach 10pm to Dawn Ocean Beach 11pm to Dawn 0

Minors must be accompanied by an adult after 10pm 0

TOMS RIVER INFORMATION

- **Garbage Collection:**
 - Place all trash in covered receptacles.
 - Do not put plastic bags at the curb.
 - Collection Dates: 0
 - May 23rd through August 30th:
 - MONDAYS & THURSDAYS
 - 0 September 2nd through May, 2020 MONDAYS ONLY
 - If Monday or Thursday is a holiday, collection will be 0 on the following day (i.e., Tuesday or Friday).
- **Recycling Collection:**
 - Recycling is mandatory in Toms River.
 - All recyclables are to be co-mingled in one properly marked receptacle with a lid, not to exceed 40 pounds or 30 gallons, not in plastic bags (except for robo-
 - cans, see below).
 This includes all glass, aluminum, tin, paper (including newspapers, magazines and "junk mail") and cardboard.
 - Collection Dates: PLEASE NOTE CHANGE FOR SUMMER MONTHS
 - May 23rd August 30th FRIDAYS
 - September 2nd May, 2020 1st and 3rd MONDAYS
- If Monday or Friday is a holiday, collection will be on the following day
- (i.e., Tuesday or Saturday).
 - Robo-Cans:
 - Robo-cans are now in use on the middle blocks between Rt. 35 N and Rt. 35 S (Marshmallow Rd -South Bayside Rd only) for both garbage and recyclables.
 - Any material left adjacent to the robo-cans will NOT be picked up. Call the Toms River DPW if you have additional garbage or recyclables to be picked up.

 - **Toms River Ordinances**
 - No trespassing on dunes. 0
 - Fireworks are not permitted at any time. 0
 - No pets permitted on No parking on streets. 0
 - 0 Observe posted speed limits
 - No smoking on the Ocean or Bay Beach at any time.

OCEAN BEACH RULES

- Swimming is permitted only in the swim area, designated by the flags, as determined by the Lifeguards.
 - Inflatable Rafts and Boogie Boards are permitted only in area designated by flags, as determined by the Lifeguards.
- Inflatable Boats, Tubes and Noodles are **NOT** permitted in the Ocean.
- Skim Boarding is only permitted outside the designated swim area.
 - Surfing is only permitted outside the designated swim
 - Fishing is only permitted outside the designated swim area.
 - Kite flying is prohibited while Lifeguards are on duty.
 - Always point umbrellas into the wind to avoid dangerous situations. On extremely windy days, Lifeguards may ask that umbrellas be taken down.

GENERAL BEACH RULES

- The Ocean and Bay Beach areas are open to the public. Badges are required.
- The Bay Beach is closed for swimming; No lifeguard is on duty. However, the Bay Beach playground, picnic area and tennis courts are
- No children under the age of 12 are allowed at the Ocean or Bay Beach unless accompanied by an adult.
- All persons 12 years and older must be in possession of a beach badge on the Ocean and Bay Beaches during the Season. Beach Badges must be worn or presented to the Badge Checker upon request.
- All instructions of the Lifeguards must be obeyed.
- Swim at your own risk.
- Do not sit directly in front of the Lifeguard stands.
- Vandalism of any sort will not be tolerated. Violators will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
- Ball playing, Frisbee throwing, paddleball playing, etc. are not permitted along the water's edge, in close proximity to sunbathers, or as otherwise directed by the Lifeguards.
- No loud music at the beaches at any time.
- No profane language at the beaches at any time.
- All trash, including cigarette and cigar butts, and recyclables must be carried off the beach and disposed of properly.
- Broken chairs and umbrellas are to be carried off the beach and disposed of properly; they are <u>not</u> to be left on the beach for the lifeguards to remove or at the top of the beach streets.
- No fires allowed at any time.
- Holes dug on the beach must be no deeper than two (2) feet and must be filled in before leaving the beach.
- No launching or beaching of motorized watercraft or non-motorized watercraft exceeding fourteen feet in length on the beaches at any
- Non-motorized watercraft fourteen feet or less in length may be launched outside the designated swim area.
- All persons launching non-motorized watercraft from the beach MUST wear a lifejacket.
- No storing of watercraft on the beaches at any time.
- Tents or canopies may **only** be placed north or south of the swim area. Small canopies for infants are permitted.
- Drones may NOT be flown over the ocean or bay beach area at any
- The mule may NOT be used to transport Members, Renters or Guests. Beach wheelchairs are available for that purpose. See the Badge Checker or a lifeguard to make arrangements for its use.

GROUND RULES

- All properties must be kept neat and clean.
- Members must comply with local regulations and health codes.
- All noise is to be kept to a minimum between the hours of 10:00pm and
- Members are responsible for the conduct of their renters and guests.
- No sleeping in any vehicle at any time.
- Renters are not allowed to bring pets to Silver Beach.
- Members must curb their pets. Pet waste must be cleaned up and carried to the Member's property for proper disposal.
