# Draft June 12, 2021 On the Beach (by Silver Beach Road)

## President's Opening Remarks

- Pete Detmering opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and a Moment of Silence for all those lost over the winter.
- Pete then went on to introduce the current EC Members and mentioned that Karen Larkin will be replacing Janet Doremus as Secretary. He also mentioned that Fred Manuel would be stepping down as the Bay Beach Trustee at the end of the year and we need a volunteer to fill that position.
- Pete then discussed the long running issue of what we can and cannot do on the beach with respect to a permanent beach structure. We finally received an opinion from the DEP that we cannot build a permanent structure anywhere on the beach, except in the exact location of the old badge house. This structure would have to be in the same place/footprint of the prior structure. Pete mentioned the EC is not in favor of this for many reasons, including the fact that it could not satisfy all the needs (storage, etc.). As a result, the EC recommends that this issue be closed; the Membership in attendance agreed. This issue is now considered closed.
- Pete went on to relay the responsibilities that Toms River has with respect to the ocean beach. Essentially, our CAFRA permit and the Easement we signed with the Army Corp states that Toms River is responsible for the maintenance of the beach; Silver Beach is not authorized to perform maintenance on the beach.
- Pete then mentioned that Toms River has instituted a curfew for Minors (17 and younger) from 10pm to 5am. He asked that those who rent their homes inform their renters.
- Pete then went on to say that Silver Beach will not permit vendors on the beach, including Beach Butler and yoga classes. He again asked those who rent their homes to inform their renters.
- Pete discussed the two proposed By-law Changes, which includes:
  - Combing the duties of the Secretary and Membership Trustee into the Secretary's role and eliminating Membership as a Trustee position and adding the Community Improvement Trustee role, to be headed by Karen Kosch, and charged with proposing any improvements Silver Beach properties.
  - Renaming the Tennis Committee/Trustee to the Tennis/Pickleball Committee/Trustee.
  - Pete asked for approval from the Membership, and all agreed.
- Pete also thanked Ann Manuel for providing the flowers at the bay beach signs.
